BEMBOKA SHOW 2025 - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 The Bemboka Show Society will not be responsible for any accidents that may be caused through or by any exhibits and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings from any such accident.
- 2 The Bemboka Show Society will not under any circumstances hold itself liable for any accidents on the ground or premises.
- 3 Exhibitors must supply persons competent to take charge of all horses.
- 4 Ridden classes will be judged under the Horse Shows Association of Australia (HSAA) rules. The Judge may disqualify from the competition any exhibit or competitor not conforming to the necessary requirements.
- 5 Horse riding can be dangerous. All riders ride at their own risk. Waivers for all persons in the main arena can be done online at time of entry. Wristbands signify a waiver has been signed. Should a rider have a fall anywhere on the showground they must pass a medical officer's check before riding again at the show.
- 6 All riders to be properly attired to meet with the approval of the Ring Stewards. Riders under 18yrs must wear a safety helmets that is current ASA compliant or equivalent. All Showjumpers helmets must be tagged as per EA ruling effective 1st January 2022
- 7 Unruly horses will be disqualified.
- 8 All protests must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$50 and must be lodged with the horse convenor within 1 hour of the close of the event. The fee will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed. In the event of protest being upheld, the next placed combination will be elevated.
- 9 Where there is a clash in the timing of events, competitors must choose between classes, as the program cannot be delayed.
- 10 All show jumping to be conducted under peak body rules & regulations. Horses may compete in 2 competitions on the day.
- 11 No refunds on scratching's.
- 12 The Bemboka Show Society reserves the right to alter the programme without notice.
- 13 All prize money to be collected on Show Day
- 14 It is the responsibility of the competitor to be familiar with the rules and conditions of entry for each class.
- 15 **Novice Classes** are for horses that have never won a Novice or Open class at any show.
- 16 Hunter Classes are for those horses that carry more substance than an ordinary show hack. If a competitor competes in a Hunter class they are not eligible to compete in Hack classes & Hacks may not compete in Hunter classes for the entire calendar year at any Agshows NSW affiliated show. Horse and rider must be appropriately attired or may be

required to change.

- 17 **District Classes** are for horses that permanently live within a radius of 20km by nearest road of the showground.
- 18 In **Ring 3 Funkana** Classes, current ASA helmets must be worn and smooth-soled boots (if using stirrups) must also be worn. Jackets are not required. Open to any horse and rider.
- 19 All horses must be registered by relevant societies to compete in breed classes. Registration papers must be available to the ring steward or the horse may be excluded from the class if proof of registration cannot be provided.

20 Western Classes

- Horses must be bitted accordingly and competitors must be appropriately attired.
- Showmanship and Hunter in Hand classes will involve pattern work provided on the day.
- Youth Western Pleasure must wear current ASA compliant or equivalent helmets.
- 21 **Property Identification Code (PIC) Numbers** have been legally required by horse owners since 2015. Land owners must obtain this number from the Local Land Service (LLS) <u>www.lls.nsw.gov.au</u> 6492 1283 for more information.
- 22 Consistent with its support for the Concussion in Sport Australia Position Statement Bemboka Show Society adopts the 'If in Doubt, Sit them Out' policy.
- 23 Highest Pointscore Most Versatile Australian Stock Horse. 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point, Champion 3 points, Reserve Champion 2 points awarded across ASH classes led & ridden excluding those classes with rider age restrictions

Bemboka Show Society is affiliated with Equestrian Australia. THE FAR SOUTH COAST SHOWJUMPER OF THE YEAR SERIES

Incorporating the Keith Gordon Senior Showjumper of the Year Award And the Graham Johnson Junior Showjumper of the Year Award

The Far South Coast Showjumper of the year series was initiated in 2009 to honour the memory of two devoted contributors of the local show jump circuit and the sport of show jumping. These awards will be presented to the HORSE and RIDER combination with the highest point score in the show jumping events of the SHOWS on the Far South Coast

RULES:

- Shows eligible for the points are: The Bega Show Jumping Cup, Candelo Show, Eurobodalla Show, Moruya, Cobargo Show, Far South Coast National Show, Bega and Bemboka Show.
- 2 There is NO minimum amount of shows that contestants are required to participate at to be eligible to score points.
- 3 Show jumping results, consisting of a single Horse and Rider entry in every ring, will be counted towards the point score. The horse/rider combinations' best 2 results per day contribute to the series pointscore.
- 4 For the purpose of this point score competition, the junior definition follows the EA definition: "All riders up to and including the calendar year in which they turn 18 (i.e. if the participant rider turns 18 in the year of competition they are an eligible junior. If they turned 18 the year before, they are senior".
- 5 Points will be awarded to the top FIVE placegetters as follows:
 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points & 5th = 1 point. In the event of equal placing, the Horse and Rider combinations will take their awarded placing points (i.e. two in 1st place take 5 points each and 3rd place takes 3 points).
- 6 Points will be awarded to the Horse and Rider combination. An individual Horse can contest both junior and senior categories if the owner so wishes, as this will not affect the point scores in anyway. Contestants must be reminded that the HORSES WELFARE must be paramount at all times.
- 7 Only the TWO Best Performances of a Horse and Rider combination per day (if applicable), per show will count towards the points score.
- 8 If a junior competes in an OPEN event and placed, they will still take the points to the junior category point score.
- 9 Contestants must be reminded that the HORSES WELFARE is paramount. In line with EA directives, a horse may only have 2 starts on the day.

Winners of the Far South Coast Showjumper of the Year series for 2025 will receive a Trophy acknowledging their outstanding achievement.

BIO-SECURITY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR COMPETITION

- Primary responsibility for bio-security at the Bemboka Show lies with the horse owner long before the event.
- Practice good bio-security, good hygiene and decontaminate equipment.
- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand wipes and waterless hand hygiene solution immediately after handling horses.
- Do not share equipment, including food and water containers, between horses. Avoid use of communal water troughs.
- Do not knowingly take sick horses to an event. If a horse is unwell at an event, notify an event official. Stewards will exclude sick horses from competition.
- Stop all non-essential contact, with the sick horse and blood or body fluid from the horse until a veterinarian has excluded Hendra virus infection as the cause of illness.
- Promptly isolate sick horses and seek veterinary advice. Also isolate any equipment in contact with the sick horse.
- It is a requirement by the NSW DPI that people who keep horses on their property need to apply for a Property Identification Code (PIC) to help trace horse movements and the spread of any major infectious diseases.

DRUG TESTING

Drug testing may be carried out at this show. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.

CAMPING FEES & POWER SUPPLY

Show ground Camping Fees are \$10 per site per day or \$15 for powered sites. Please note that electricity power sockets will be turned off from the mains switchboard from 8.00am on Show Day. This is for safety reasons and to avoid overburdening the electrical circuits. Should you need electricity during these hours please contact the main Show Office.

NB: Safety regulations necessitate that the erection of **Electric Fencing** be restricted to competitor only areas adjacent to the show jumping arena. **No Electric Fencing or star pickets** are to be placed between the cattle yards and the trade stand area owing to underground water pipes & electrical cables. **BYO portable steel yards for this area.**
